Hilton Head fifth graders named local winners of 2022 Children's Book Challenge

Life of a Solar Panel, by Jack Cerrati, Austin Wiedemann, Kolby Anthony and Samere "Isaiah" Tyson, was selected as Palmetto Electric Cooperative's local winner of the 2022 Children's Book Challenge, sponsored by EnlightenSC, an educational initiative of South Carolina's electric cooperatives.

The competition challenges fourth and fifth grade students to write and illustrate stories that focus on cooperatives, sustainability and the impact of electricity. Local winners' books are then entered into a statewide competition for a chance to win \$500 and have their book published and distributed to elementary schools throughout the state.

After being selected as Palmetto Electric's local winner, *Life of a Solar Panel* was awarded a first-ever, second place prize in the EnLightenSC statewide competition.

Jack, Austin, Kolby and Isaiah, fifth graders at Hilton Head Island Elementary School for the Creative Arts, were recognized along with their teachers, Jennifer Friend-Kerr and Alex Holland, during a presentation in their classroom on April 19. Missy Santorum, public relations manager for Palmetto Electric Cooperative, presented the winning team with certificates and gift cards.
